God even answers our dumb questions....

- What must I do to inherit eternal life?
 - Now honey, exactly how often do I need to tell you I love you so you'll be happy, maybe I can do something with the guys and maybe we can do something, you know, a later....
 - Jesus replies, What is written... literally means can you read?
 - Worldview.... Love God and love people... live life at the intersection
 - He got it in his head but his heart and hands didn't weren't connected.... Who is my neighbor?
- Good Samaritan
- Half dead, beat up.... Opens his one good eye that is left.. Is it another thief, a rival gang member... oh it is a priest.... The pastor

1. The Priest.... goes to the other side

- On his religious list of things that make God happy he failed.
- He had appointments to keep with religious people
- Has Church business to attend to
- MAYBE it was this guys fault, he shouldn't have been traveling here, he is a rival gang member, he deserved it.
- What if I am helping a bad guy
- **He went out of his way to avoid doing the right thing**
- **Syrian Refuges, Black Lives Matter, Shootings in New Orleans, 52% unemployment....**
- **Isn't it like God to put people where you can't help but see them.... Work, school, neighbors God puts them in your path**

2. The Levite.... Goes to the other side

- God's law says he can't touch a dead person... Good rule, don't touch dead people
- If he touches him he will be contaminated for 7 days and he won't be able to do his job, his church job
- Maybe just maybe, we are so busy doing so many thing that it is really easy for us to turn into Levites and walk right past the people who are around us
- Proactive in connecting with my neighbors...
- Proactive in being with people not just reactive
- Reactive... it is easy to blow people off
- Need to me intentional in my understanding what God desires

- Princeton Study Pg. 91 Life on Mission (1973) Dr. Darley and Batson
 - Two groups to give presentations.
 - 1. Seminary jobs
 - 2. Good Samaritan
 - Asked to go from one building to another. Some had plenty of time, others no time
 - 10% of the people in a hurry stopped
 - 63% of the people not in a hurry stopped

- **Results**

The amount of "hurriness" induced in the subject had a major effect on helping behavior, but the task variable did not (even when the talk was about the Good Samaritan).

Overall 40% offered some help to the victim. In low hurry situations, 63% helped, medium hurry 45% and high hurry 10%. For helping-relevant message 53%, task relevant message 29%. There was no correlation between "religious types" and helping behavior. The only variable that showed some effect was "religion as a quest". Of the people who helped, those who saw religion as a quest were less likely to offer substantial help than those who scored low on this statement. But later analysis revealed this may not be caused by real religious differences.

Conclusions

Ironically, a person in a hurry is less likely to help people, even if he is going to speak on the parable of the Good Samaritan. (Some literally stepped over the victim on their way to the next building!). The results seem to show that thinking about norms does not imply that one will act on them. Maybe that "ethics become a luxury as the speed of our daily lives increases". Or maybe people's cognition was narrowed by the hurriedness and they failed to make the immediate connection of an emergency.

3. The Samaritan...

- Remember the story is for the church people, the priests and Levites, doubt there were any Samaritans hanging out there
 - Listen.... You religious people think you are loving God well.... Well..... you ain't
 - Pagans are doing a better job

 - This LA in 50's and a white man lying in the ditch and an African American stopping.... This is a Black Lives Matter protester helping a white Supremacist shooter.... Catholic and Protestant in Northern Ireland... Palestinian Christian helping a Jew
- Compassion = Splachna – come from the gut.... Deep innermost felling
- ***"A deep feeling of sharing in the suffering of another and the desire to relieve that suffering"* Jerry Bridges**
- Luke 1:40-41: A man with leprosy came to Jesus and begged him on his knees, if you are willing, please, you can make me clean. Filled with compassion, Jesus reached out his hand and touched the man. Immediately, the leprosy left him, and he was cured"
- He helped him.... Bandaged his wounds, took him to the inn, gave 2 weeks wages.... Said he would come back
- Helped, he didn't drop everything, not all his time, not all his money..... WHEN I COME BACK
- Now go and do likewise
- God wants to answer a need through you...

1. Stop

- Stop passing by people who are hurting
- Stop living this crazy American dream long enough to get engaged in your neighbors, co-workers, fellow students lives
- Stop pretending that you don't see people in need
- Stop pretending that it is their fault
- Stop and "lift up your eyes and look on the fields, that they are white for harvest.
- Stop talking about how you are going to get around to it,
- STOP giving excuses
- STOP worry about the right way to do it
- Stop viewing all charity as toxic Luke 5:42ff

2. Drop

- Drop off your donkey
- Get off your high horse
- The good Samaritan had to get off his donkey
- KJV would have called the donkey something else..... get off your donkey... insert the KJV here
- If you are a disciple of Christ, one of God's children through faith... you have to get off your high horse and serve people

3. Roll

- Roll up your sleeves
